Final paper should be submitted for publication in International Law Journal on Trade, Business & Economics (ILJTBE) E Journal before deadline (Optional).  4. The preferred length of paper (including footnotes) is 5,000 words (maximum limit). In general, please confine your pape between 10-12 pages, everything included.  5. Authors' autobiographical details should appear as the first footnote of each contribution, and include the name, academi and professional qualifications, institutional affiliation, current title and position of each author.  6.
